

JMA Active 2009

Junior Mission for All is an education programme for children. It encourages children in Ireland to learn about, pray for and serve children in other countries. Each year, hundreds of children all over Ireland collect for JMA. Half the funds go towards a **Methodist Missionary Society (Ireland)** project overseas and half goes towards a Methodist **Home Mission** project within Ireland. **JMA Active 2009** has been produced to help leaders encourage learning through chat, games, quizzes, prayers and craft.

2009 Projects: Overseas – children’s projects in South Africa
Ireland – the Funky Fish Café in Bandon, Cork

This pack contains

South African materials: These are printed on white paper and contain four lesson plans with stories, prayers, craft, games, recipes and much more

Funky Fish Café Materials: These are printed on yellow paper and contain activities and puzzles

Service ideas: Ideas for a talk and elements of a church service that can be used to present what the children have been learning about.

What should happen to funds collected for the projects?
