

JMA Active 2010



Junior Mission for All is an education programme for children. It encourages children in Ireland to learn about, pray for and serve children in other countries. Each year, hundreds of children all over Ireland collect for JMA. Half the funds go towards a **Methodist Missionary Society (Ireland)** project overseas and half goes towards a Methodist **Home Mission** project within Ireland. **JMA Active 2010** has been produced to help leaders encourage learning through chat, games, quizzes, prayers and craft.

This pack contains

What should happen to funds collected for the projects?
