During the summer she had a youth event which was attended by over 100 young people. It was her first time to address so many people in Spanish. It was also the first time these young people had attended a Christian Youth event and got to meet neighboring Christians.

Melissa has started giving 2 English classes, one in a small village and the other in a larger church which is involved in a child sponsorship programme.

Stephen has been serving for 5 years in Ibiza and has set up an outreach in the West end of San Antonio. It is a 24-7 operation and exists to care for the emotional, and physical needs of the community. Stephen raises his own financial support to be able to carry out this work. It might be something we could think about.

The work in Ibiza has changed greatly in the last few years. Initially it was mainly helping vulnerable young holiday makers with drink and drug problems. Now it provides the homeless with food, washing facilities and a listening ear. Stephen also works with the prisons. This work is carried out alone by Stephen with occasional summer help from volunteers. He has started Alpha courses.

Barry & Gillian have been serving in East Germany since 1999. They are helping to restore Chemnitz to the beautiful peaceful city it once was. The area got very delipated and was affected by racism. 85% of the area is atheist however they are making an impact on the locals with their hospitality. People who

previously rejected an thoughts of church are now befriending them. Barry works 50% as director of Evangelism for Methodist church in Germany and the remainder for MCI. His work in some ways is similar to the work of the Home Mission Dept. as it includes church planting, evangelism and church planting. The way of doing things at Inspire in Germany is very different to here and we would have difficulty accepting the way it is done. It works for them and the gospel message is the same.
