

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR THE POST OF CHURCH FAMILY DEVELOPMENT WORKER ON THE LISBURN & DROMORE METHODIST CIRCUIT

JOB TITLE:

POST – CHURCH FAMILY DEVELOPMENT WORKER
LOCATION – TRINITY METHODIST CHURCH, LISBURN

PURPOSE OF THE JOB

The post is a full-time position (36 hours per week) and will involve the post-holder working across 4 congregations as a member of the staff team on the Lisburn & Dromore Methodist Circuit. The principle role of the post is to initiate, refocus, develop and lead ministry with families across the Broomhedge, Magheragall, Priesthill and Trinity Societies. Each of these congregations are different, and the post-holder's role and function will vary for each, whilst working within the overall vision of the Circuit.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Required to be a Christian and to work and communicate with respect to "Methodist Belief".
- To take a lead in developing outreach and ministry among families in the circuit
- To pray for and with families in the circuit
- To take an active role in conducting Sunday services within the circuit
- To engage with families connected with the circuit and encourage them to be involved in the life of the societies
- To liaise with other church leaders in the area to support family ministry
- To seek to partner with other organisations, particularly faith-based organisations, working together to enhance family ministry
- To pastorally support families in the circuit
- To uphold a biblical model of family

REPORTING TO

The Person appointed will report to the convenor of a circuit support/management group

WORKING HOURS

This is a full-time (36 hrs/week) fixed term contract for 3 years (with the possibility of extension) subject to review after a 6-month probation period.

Working some evenings and regular weekends, including Sunday mornings, will be a requirement of the position.

SALARY

The salary will be in the range £21,153 - £22,300 plus allowances
